

VILLAGE OF CREMONA - BYLAW 484-18
ROAD CLOSURE

A Bylaw of the Village of Cremona in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing public travel and disposing of portions of a public highway in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, Revised Statutes Of Alberta 2000, as amended.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Cremona deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and therefore disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and


WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of Cremona in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of disposing of the following lane, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

*All that portion of Lane created on Plan 981 0006 that is adjacent to Lot 1 and Lot 2 containing 0.061 ha.
(0.151 ac.) more or less*
