3 b) 2017 Capital Budget

The Village of Cremona does not use tax monies to fund Capital Projects. Grants, borrowing and reserves are how capital projects are funded

With the new changes in the MGA, a minimum of a 5 year Capital Budget is required. This will be beneficial as the municipality can take advantage of getting projects out for tender a lot quicker.

2017 projects discussed are listed below in order of priority. Funding will depend upon what projects can be done in 2017. Projects not done in 2017 will be put in the Capital Plan for 2018.

- 1. Pave Edey Close
- 2. Open 1st Avenue but do not pave; put in curb and sidewalk look at stormwater
- 3. Pave Centre Street to 1st Street West
- 4. Finish Paving 1st East up to 3rd Avenue
- 5. Install new Fire Hydrant at Centre Street and 2nd Avenue

Res. 068-17 MOTION: Moved by Councillor Temple that Council direct Administration to bring back the 2017 Capital Budget at the April 18, 2017 Regular Council Meeting with the projects as discussed.

9 c) Water Consumption Rate

At the February 13, 2017 Budget Meeting; Council was presented with a recommendation to increase the water rate from $\$3.36/m^3$ to $\$3.60/m^3$ so that tax dollars are not subsidizing water and wastewater consumption.

When Administration was going to input the new changes for April 1, 2017; it was found that the current rate was already in the Muniware system at \$3.60.m³. Previous to the conversion it was \$3.36/m³. From September 2016 to February 2017 residents have been charged an extra 24 cents per cubic meter. To rectify the situation, Administration will be working with Muniware to calculate the overpayment and refund each utility account.
