The December Council Meeting had a short agenda therefore the highlights from this meeting are minimal.

PUBLIC BUDGET MEETING

Council received the first draft of the 2017 Operating Budget on November 29th. It is being recommended that a public budget meeting take place prior to any further changes or discussions take place.

Council approved to hold the Public Budget Meeting on February 13, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. at 112 Railway Avenue (FCSS Office).

WORKSHOP WITH URBAN SYSTEMS
