Council Meeting Highlights — May 16, 2017

Diabetes Clothing Bin

Diabetes Canada requested to form a partnership with the Village of Cremona to place a clothing recycling bin in the community. Council defeated the motion for one to be placed in the Village. Jen Thompson gave a presentation and asked council to reconsider placing a bin in the community.

Council approved a municipal partnership between Diabetes Canada and the Village of Cremona for clothing recycling bin and Council rescinded resolution 084-17.

October Meeting Schedule

The Municipal Election is October 16, 2017. The October Council meeting is set for October 17, 2017. With so much going on and due to the election, some meeting dates may need to be changed.

Council approved October 10, 2017 as the last council meeting for the current council; and that October 21, 2017 be set as the swearing in of the new council and orientation; and November 7, 2017 will be the Organizational Meeting.

Advanced Voting for 2017 Municipal Election

Council approved Friday, October 7, 2017 from 12 noon to 7 pm; and Saturday October 8, 2017 from 9 am to 3 pm for the Advanced Vote located at the Cremona United Church Hall.

Waste Commission Amendment to Agreement

Council approved the request from Mountain View Regional Waste Management Commission for an amendment to the Membership Agreement.

The AUMA's summer Mayor's Caucus is being held at the Best Western Inn in Okotoks, Alberta. Council discussed who would attend this meeting.

Council approve to send the CAO, and any Council members who wish to attend the AUMA Summer Mayor's Caucus on June 13, 2017 in Okotoks, Alberta.

Council Remuneration

The Remuneration Committee met on May 3rd to review and discuss Policy 1601-01 Remuneration and Expense.

Council agreed not to make any changes to Policy 1601-01 for Council Remuneration.

Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework Discussion Protocols

Council approved the Village of Cremona/Mountain View County Discussion Protocols for the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework (ICF).

Farm Safety Centre

The Farm Safety Centre provides province wide farm safety educational programs. Council approved to support the Farm Safety Centre in the amount of \$200.00 for 2017 with funds coming from the Council Community Grants & Enhancement budget.

Citizen Satisfaction Survey Results

The Citizen Satisfaction Survey was mailed to all residents in the Village as well as available on-line. The results were presented to council for their review and information and they are also available on the village's website.
