

Cremona supports waste commission bylaws

Village of Cremona council indicated its support of Mountain View Regional Waste Management Commission's new bylaws by accepting them for information during the Oct. 20 meeting.

The commission asked that all member councils support three new bylaws, including one that deals with board appointments and the chair, one stating how rates and fees would be assessed, as well as the commission's corporate bylaw.

Council also passed a motion to rescind its letter of withdrawal to the commission following an in-camera session during the Aug. 25 meeting.

The village served one year's notice to withdraw from the commission in December of 2014 after the commission increased its 2015 requisitions significantly to its member municipalities to make up for financial losses.

The municipalities of Carstairs, Didsbury and Sundre also served one year's notice of withdrawal at that time; however, all municipalities have now rescinded their letters of withdrawal.
